**Next Steps:**

After reviewing this document, the Board will identify the options where the funds for the 2007 logging of the land. The Board has the ability to select multiple options and then determine the amount of money to be designated to each of the options. Even though options selected may have the same or similar scores, options may require different amounts of dollars to be actualized. For example, more money this year may be needed to start an endowment and less in the following years. Decisions should be recorded in minutes of meetings. The income and expenditures of this money needs to be part of the annual audit report for the Sawyer County 4-H Leaders Association.

The criteria developed and agreed upon can be used for other decisions the Sawyer County 4-H Board of Directors or Leaders Association makes. Criteria can also be changed or and the weight assigned be reevaluated as situations change within the county. It is important that the criteria and its weight be agreed to prior to options being considered.

**Parking Lot Items:**

These items were discussed and placed in the parking lot for consideration in the future.

- The clarification on the language of the property deed, restrictions and ownership of the money. A title search done that confirms ownership as well as affirms that restrictions are common. You have sought an opinion of corporation council regarding restrictions on deed, need for clearer language and he had no issues with the proposed changes.
