Sunday, June 10th, from 2-4 P.M.

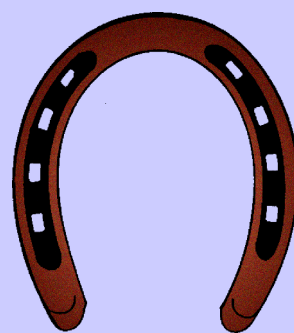
Sunday, July 15th, from 2-4 P.M.
